

SUBCONTRACT ADDENDUM

1. California Labor Code sections 1771, 1773.1, 1775, 1776, 1777.5, 1813, and 1815, copies of which are attached hereto, are incorporated into the parties' _____ [INSERT NAME OF AGREEMENT OR JOB ORDER] ("AGREEMENT" OR "JOB ORDER"). _____ [INSERT SUBCONTRACTOR NAME AS DEFINED IN AGREEMENT/JOB ORDER] ("SUBCONTRACTOR") agrees to comply with these and all other provisions of the California Prevailing Wage Law, which is codified in California Labor Code sections 1720 *et seq.*

2. Prior to final payment being issued by Inframark, LLC to SUBCONTRACTOR for work performed on the Project described in the AGREEMENT OR JOB ORDER, SUBCONTRACTOR agrees to execute and deliver the attached affidavit confirming under penalty of perjury that SUBCONTRACTOR has paid the prevailing rate of per diem wages specified in the applicable Wage Determination(s) to all employees of SUBCONTRACTOR for work performed on the Project, as well any amounts due pursuant to California Labor Code section 1813, and that SUBCONTRACTOR has employed the requisite number of apprentices for the Project in accordance with California Labor Code section 1777.5.

3. SUBCONTRACTOR agrees to indemnify and hold harmless CONTRACTOR from any fines, forfeitures, damages, liabilities, losses, penalties, assessments, attorneys' fees, costs, and any other expenses arising out of or in any way related to the failure of SUBCONTRACTOR to comply with the above-referenced California Labor Code provisions.

4. SUBCONTRACTOR shall submit certified payroll records to CONTRACTOR upon request, which shall be provided no later than five (5) business days following such request. The payroll records shall be prepared in accordance with, and contain all of the information required by, California Labor Code section 1776.

5. For each classification of workmen employed by SUBCONTRACTOR on the Project who perform work in an apprenticeable trade or craft, SUBCONTRACTOR shall provide CONTRACTOR with completed and signed copies of the Notification of Contract Award (DAS 140) and Request for Dispatch of Apprentice (DAS 142) that comply in all respects with the requirements of California Labor Code section 1777.5 and California Code of Regulations. Title 8, section 230.1.

6. SUBCONTRACTOR shall provide CONTRACTOR with proof of payment of all fringe benefit contributions provided and/or required to be provided with respect to all persons employed by SUBCONTRACTOR to perform work on the Project, and proof of payment of all training contributions paid by SUBCONTRACTOR to the appropriate apprentice training committee or the California Apprentice Council for each hour of work performed by all such persons on the Project.

7. SUBCONTRACTOR certifies that it is a public work contractor registered with the Department of Industrial Relations.

4. The required number of apprentices have been employed by SUBCONTRACTOR on the Project, in accordance with California Labor Code section 1777.5.
